

# ENTRY GRADE KNOWLEDGE SHARPE

Knowledge counts for 20% of your final Examination mark. This takes place at the end of the exam after your performance. You will sit down with the examiner to answer the questions below.



## 1) What is the appearance of your character?

## 2) How is your character feeling in the scene?

### In **appearance** you can talk about the following:



### EXAMPLE (Whizziwig): What is the appearance of your character?

I think Whizziwig is an alien with green skin, two antenii, three eyes and big webbed feet. I think Whizziwig is very small, possibly half my size. I think because Whizziwig has been staying in Ben's bedroom he may have found one of ben's old t-shirts to put on.

# In **feelings** try to split the scene into three sections (Beginning, Middle and End). You must always give a reason for why your character is feeling that way. Here are some examples of feeling words you could use.



### EXAMPLE (Whizziwig): How is your character feeling in the scene?

At the beginning of the scene Whizziwig is feeling nervous as he is unsure how Ben will react to seeing him. In the Middle Whizziwig gets a little annoyed because he is trying to get Ben to wish for his ship to be fixed and Ben just asks for a new bike. At the end of the scene Whizziwig is feeling proud as he has told Ben all about being an Oricon and Whizziwig enjoys his job.
