

THE STORY

In roaring twenties Chicago, chorus girl Roxie Hart murders a faithless lover and convinces her hapless husband, Amos, to take the rap... until he finds out he's been duped and turns on Roxie. Convicted and sent to death row, Roxie and another 'Merry Murderess,' Velma Kelly, vie for the spotlight and the headlines, ultimately joining forces in search of the 'American Dream': fame, fortune, and acquittal. WHAT DO STUDENTS NEED TO WEAR?

All students will need a base layer for the show week rehearsals and performances.

Students must have the correct base layer in order to take part in the production.

- Hair should be kept away from the face at all times. Ensemble girls should wear long hair in a ponytail. Principal girls' hair should be worn as directed.
- Glasses should not be worn if at all possible. If a student has a strong optical prescription and cannot perform without glasses, these MUST be secured with a strap, available from all opticians.
- **Jewellery**, including earrings, is not permitted during any rehearsal or performance. Students should therefore avoid getting any new piercings in the weeks before Chicago as these will have to be removed. Jewellery should be left at home.

FOOD & DRINK

Students should have had lunch/dinner before they arrive for the Wednesday and Thursday rehearsals and both performance days. They should bring a packed dinner to have between the two Saturday performances. Students should also bring a named refillable water bottle and snacks. Breaks will be supervised by our registered chaperones.

STUDENTS' BELONGINGS

- All belongings should be kept in a named zipped bag. Sharpe Academy accepts no responsibility for any student belongings or valuables.
- **Mobile phones** are not permitted during any rehearsals or performances, except while students are on a break. Phones used during rehearsal or performance times will be confiscated by our staff and returned at the end of that session.

Concessions: Children under 16, Senior Citizens, Students and Wheelchair users. **Group tickets** can be split across different performances but must be booked and paid for in the same transaction. A **Family Ticket** is 4 tickets for the same performance consisting of 2 Adults and 2 Concessions.

SEATING INFORMATION: Rows A–L will be removed to provide additional performance space. Rows Q–Y are tiered seating. Rows AA–CC are balcony seats at the rear of the auditorium. Rows M–P are on floor level and will have a restricted view of the performance area.
