WATFORD FESTIVAL

If you would like to enter your child into The Watford Festival you can do so via their website at https://www.watfordfestival.co.uk before 6th December 2019. The Watford Festival is a competition where children aged 4-18 compete for medals & trophies and receive feedback from adjudicators. Competitions take place after February half term and throughout March during evenings and weekends.

SINGING / SPEAKING

In their ACT 1 class, children learn vocal technique exercises, warm up songs and a variety of songs from the world of Musical Theatre & Film.

After singing, students work on their Public Speaking and Listening skills by sitting in a circle and sharing their news from the previous week.

We teach the LAMDA Introductory Examination Syllabus. This involves learning set poetry – children can take up to three speaking exams (additional exam fees apply).

DANCE / MOVEMENT

Children learn a combination of dance warm ups and a variety of jazz dance routines. They also work on physical games designed to get them moving and teach basic interaction skills with other children.

Additional Dance Classes

Children can take optional additional Ballet and/or Modern classes as well as their Musical Theatre class (additional fees apply).

PERFORMANCE

Open Class Presentation

Once a year we hold an open class for parents to watch the development of their child in a relaxed, informal atmosphere.

These end-of-term presentations are expected to take place on the last day of the Autumn term 2020 during the normal class time. **Dates are to be confirmed**.

Theatre Show Presentation

At the end of each academic year we hold a theatre style presentation for children to perform to family and friends. This is staged as professionally as possible in a theatre venue with lights, sound and costumes. **SAVE THE DATE – SUNDAY 5TH JULY.**

CONFIDENCE

Confidence can take a few years to build, but can last a lifetime.

Our ACT 1 class is designed to build the confidence of a child so they are in a good position to start our ACT 2 class. We very much see the ACT 1 class as being a foundation block to introduce children to:

UNIFORM

We kindly request that parents ensure children wear the correct uniform to class every week:

SUPERVISION

Children in Nursery, Reception and Year 1 are in classes with a child to staff ratio of 8:1. Our teaching staff are not only fully DBS-checked but are also registered chaperones. All our classes have Teachers and Assistant Teachers making sure children are well supervised. All centres have a manager on site at all times who is in charge of child protection and trained in First Aid.

FEEDBACK and REPORTS

As this is a performance-based activity class and not an academic class, we do not give feedback or reports. We will however always let you know if there is anything your child needs to practice at home. LAMDA always provide written reports if your child takes an examination.

Parents are able to see the individual progression and development of their child during our class presentations and performances.

The folk who live in Backward Town


Are inside out and upside down.
