

At Sharpe Academy, musical theatre and performance is at the core of everything we do. Our classes are tailored to each age group and enable students to build confidence and skills including public speaking and presentation, which will help them in a broad range of career paths.

We also prepare our students for a career in Performing Arts — Sharpe is also a full-time College, offering 3 Year Diploma, 2 Year Accelerated Diploma, and 1 Year Postgraduate courses in Professional Musical Theatre and Acting.

Children in our part-time classes, whether aged 3 or 18, are taught by some of the same experienced industry professional as our College students.





Musical Theatre Classes

- Act 1 Musical Theatre is a weekly 45-minute class which includes Singing, Dance and Public Speaking. Children also work on the LAMDA Introductory Verse & Prose syllabus and have the option of taking these exams. This class is ideal for building confidence in young children
- Act 2 and Act 3 Musical Theatre are weekly 2-hour classes which include Singing, Acting
 and Dance. All students take part in full-scale Musical Theatre productions and have the option
 of working towards LAMDA Acting exams.
- Our London Musical Theatre Company is a weekly 2.5-hour class for young performers
 who love musical theatre as a hobby, those who are passionate about performing and who
 may be considering pursuing it as a career. All students take part in full-scale Musical Theatre
 productions and can audition for principal roles. They too have the option of working towards
 LAMDA Acting exams.

Additional Dance Classes

We also run a range of optional dance classes for students who wish to add to their Musical Theatre training. These classes include **Ballet**, **Modern**, **Tap** and **Acrobatics**; through these classes, students can take Dance and Acro exams with the ISTD or Acrobatic Arts examining boards.



The Full Year Commitment (Options 1, 2 & 3) applies to ALL classes including Ballet, Modern, Tap, Acrobatics and Jazz. Students can add additional Dance/Acro classes at any point during the year, subject to availability.

CLASS DISCOUNT OPTIONS*

- The 20% Discount for Options 1 and 2 applies to all classes and is available to all currently enrolled students and to new students in September 2024.
- For new students joining in January, the Option 1 and 2 discount is reduced to 10% when committing to the spring and summer terms.
- For new students joining after February half term, only Option 3 is available and no discounts are given. However, split monthly payments for the rest of the academic year (up to and including June 2025) can be arranged.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS

A 25% Sibling Discount applies to all classes (in addition to the full-year discount shown above, if applicable). The eldest child or the child taking the most classes pays full fees and siblings receive the 25% discount.

MONTHLY DIRECT DEBITS

Direct Debit payments (Options 1 & 3) are collected on or shortly after the FIRST day of each month.

Direct Debit Charges

We are charged by GoCardless for each unsuccessful Direct Debit payment. To cover this charge, we will add a small fee for each missed payment. The payment amount and this fee must be paid by Bank Transfer; full details will be provided should this be necessary. Your automatic payments will continue as normal from the following month.

Fees are reviewed each academic year.

A **Show Fee of £50 per student** is charged for Act 2, Act 3 and Company students for our **February musical** and **July Gala**, and for **Dance-only** students who choose to take part in the Gala. This goes towards additional show week costs. Principals will be expected to sell a minimum of 10 tickets each.

At Sharpe we place a strong emphasis on performance. We aim to give all our students in all our classes the chance to perform on stage throughout the year.

Act 1 Showcases

Our **Act 1 children** present a Christmas performance to their parents & families in an **Open Class** during the final class of the autumn term. They also have their own **end-of-year Showcase** on the last day of the summer term.

Full Scale Musicals

Our full-scale musical productions are performed in the stunning Grade II listed **Elliott Hall Theatre** at Harrow Arts Centre. These feature all students from our Act 2, Act 3 and London Company classes.

In February 2025, all Musical Theatre students in our Act 2, Act 3 and London Company classes will present Disney's **Beauty and the Beast**. Rehearsals and performances will take place from **Tuesday 18th to Saturday 22nd February 2025**. New students who join these classes in September 2024 will also take part.

Over the past 16 years of part-time classes, we have presented a wide range of musicals including Beauty and the Beast, Aida, Fame, Legally Blonde, Chitty Chitty Bang Bang, The Wizard of Oz, West Side Story and many more. In 2016 we broke the official Guinness World Record for the Fastest Theatrical Production with our performance of Annie. The musical was revealed to us at 6am in the morning; we then cast, rehearsed and performed the full show 15 hours later. We are proud to have held that record for over 3 years.

The last full musical our part-time students performed before Covid was **Oliver!**, back in February 2020. When the first lockdown hit us all in March, our Company students were ready to present **Chicago** in April and it became 'the musical that never was'.

We finally returned to the stage in July 2021 when all our part-time students performed The Hunchback of Notre Dame. The big difference this time around was that we sadly were not allowed an audience – so we filmed the show and released a DVD. Our part-time musical for 2023 was Andrew Lloyd Webber's Cats. This was an ambitious dance production and we were incredibly proud of our Act 2, Act 3 and Company students who all took part. Our most recent Musical production was Disney's The Little Mermaid in February 2024.

Gala Showcases

We finish the academic year with a **Gala Showcase** presented by Act 2, Act 3 and Company students, which in 2025 will take place on **Saturday 5th July**. Our Dance-only students also have the option of taking part this performance, .
